## Reading Intent

### What are we trying to achieve for our learners through our reading curriculum?

At Crockenhill Primary School, reading is paramount and is a key driver for our curriculum.

It is our intention to ensure that by the end of their primary education, all pupils are fluent, independent and confident readers across the curriculum, which will prepare them well for the next stages of education. Therefore, we intend to encourage all pupils to read widely across both fiction and non-fiction to develop knowledge of themselves and the world in which they live; to establish an appreciation and passion for reading; to gain knowledge across the curriculum; and to develop their inference and comprehension skills. We are committed to providing vocabulary-rich, challenging and enjoyable reading material for all of our pupils.

## Implementation

### How will we provide a high-quality reading curriculum?

- The systematic teaching of phonics has a high priority throughout the Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1, as well as for any pupils in Key Stage 2 that require further phonics support. Phonics is taught daily to all children in EYFS and KS1 following the DfE validated Twinkl Phonics SSP Program. Staff systematically teach learners the relationship between phonemes and the written spelling patterns, or graphemes, which represent them. Timely intervention is planned for those children who are working below expected levels as soon as needs are identified and for some, phonic teaching will continue beyond Year 2.
- In EYFS and Key Stage 1 there are daily opportunities for reading, either individually or in small groups. Children progress through the Rhino Readers scheme, phonetically matched with the Twinkl SSP, in school and take home other books to read for pleasure.
- In Key Stage 2, reading will be taught through whole class sessions, focussing on comprehension and fluency skills as well as continuing to develop decoding and vocabulary. Children needing extra support will receive intervention. The whole class reading sessions introduce pupils to a variety of genres and are used to teach a range of techniques, which enable children to comprehend the meaning of what they read.
- All classrooms have their own class reading areas with a variety of books, available for children to borrow and take home to read for pleasure. Classes also have access to our school library both during school hours and during the open library sessions, which take place weekly and are open to parents and carers.
- Teachers regularly read to children in all year groups, with story time scheduled daily. We also use a core text approach for our writing curriculum so that pupils are exposed to a range of rich texts daily.

## Impact

### How will we assess our reading curriculum?

- Phonics is tracked half termly and the tracking is analysed to inform teaching and the need for intervention.
- Reading sessions are planned using the National Curriculum objectives and class teachers assess the children's progress using on-going assessment for learning. Intervention will be provided for any children not achieving at least age-related expectations.
- Termly assessments will be carried out using Rising Stars assessment papers in KS1 and NFER assessment papers in Years 3-5. Year 6 pupils will use national test materials. Class teachers will also use Target Tracker statements for ongoing teacher assessments.
