

In English this term, we will be practicing writing simple sentences consolidating our knowledge of using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will look closely at when to use capital letters. We will also begin to use adjectives in our writing to add description.

In Science, our topic is *Animals Including Humans*. We will think about human body parts, our senses and which body parts we use for these senses. We will also learn about the 5 different animal groups. We will compare these animal groups and think about the diets of different animals.

In RE, we are learning about what it means to belong to a faith community.

In Geography, we are learning about the UK. We will learn about the four countries that make up the UK and their capital cities. We will compare what cities and the countryside are like. We will also learn about some famous London landmarks.

In maths, we will be consolidating our knowledge from last year by learning about place value within 10. We will be counting, thinking about one more and one less and comparing numbers using $<$, $>$ and $=$. We will also consolidate our knowledge of addition and subtraction within 10. We will be partitioning numbers and thinking about number bonds.

Autumn Term

We will be improving our mouse skills by practicing using the mouse to log on, draw shapes and a self-portrait.

In PSHE, our topic is family and relationships. We will think about what a family is and what friendships are. We will learn about how to recognise other people's emotions as well as how to solve issues that we might have with
