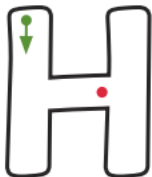




Reception Home Learning Activities

Literacy/Phonics:

Activity 1: Practice your letter formation, focusing on the capital letters: H, I, J. Practice writing them in your book using the letter formation rhymes below.



Draw two straight lines down from the top to the bottom. Join them with a line across the middle.

Start at the top, draw a straight line down then add a short line across the top and bottom.

Draw a straight line down, then a short curve to the left. Add a short line across the top.

Activity 2: This week, we are learning how to write captions using a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop. Have a go at writing some captions (attached separately) for the pictures in your book. There are caption suggestions on the last page of the document.

Topic:

This week, we have been learning about animals that live on a farm.

Activity 1: Make a list of all of the farm animals you can name e.g. cow, pig, goat. Can you find out the names of baby farm animals?

Activity 2: Choose one farm animal and find out an interesting fact about it. You could also create a painting or a model of your chosen animal to add to our Amazing Animals display. Please see some examples below:



Mathematics:

This week, we have been learning about complex repeating patterns.

Activity 1: Create your own repeating stripy pattern on a snake. Try to include at least 3 different colours that repeat. For example, orange, blue, blue, green, orange, blue, blue, green. A template of a snake is attached or you could draw your own in your home learning book.
