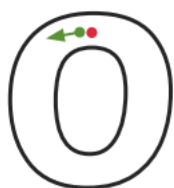
## Literacy/Phonics:

**Activity 1:** Practice your letter formation, focusing on the capital letters: N, O, P.

Practice writing them in your book using the letter formation rhymes below.



Draw a straight line down, go back up to the top, slide down to the right then go straight up again.



A capital 'o' is the same as a lower-case 'o'. Just remember to make it bigger.



Start at the top, draw a straight line down, go back up and round to the right.



**Activity 2:** This week, we are re-capping Level 3 sounds and tricky words. Please complete some activities from the Phonics Workbook attached.

## Topic:

This week, we have been learning about minibeasts habitats.

**Activity 1:** World Bee Day is celebrated on 20<sup>th</sup> May. Design a poster to help others understand why it is important to look after bees.

**Activity 2:** Build your own Bug Hotel using natural and recycled materials. Think about which insects might like to visit your minibeast hotel. You could hang your bug hotel or place it in a grassy/mud area. Check back on your bug hotel over the next few days/weeks and see which insects come to pay a visit.
