## Literacy/Phonics:

**Activity 1:** Practice your letter formation, focusing on the capital letters: Q, R, S.

Practice writing them in your book using the letter formation rhymes below.



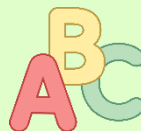
Start at the top and go all the way around. Then draw a little line across at the bottom right.



Draw a straight line down, go back up to the top, round to the middle and kick out.



A capital 's' is the same as a lower-case 's'. Just remember to make it bigger.



**Activity 2:** Please complete some activities from the Level 4 phonics mat.

## Topic:

This week, we have been learning facts about different sea creatures.

**Activity 1:** Tell an adult about your favourite sea creature. Can you remember any facts about your chosen creature?

Create your sea creature from playdough or construction materials.



## Mathematics:

This week, we have been exploring tangram puzzles in class. We used the tangram shapes to make different pictures.

**Activity 1:**

Carefully cut out your tangram pieces from card and see if you can use them to make the sea creatures in the pictures. Remember, you might need to turn the shapes around to make them fit.

Can you use all 7 tangram pieces to complete each sea creature? Which one do you think is the trickiest?

Challenge: Can you create your own underwater creature using all 7 tangram pieces? We would love to see your amazing creations!

Below is a list of words we have been using in the classroom this week. Please encourage the use of these words at home:

- habitat
- Ocean
- Sea creatures: whale, shark, seahorse, jellyfish, octopus, starfish
- Shape
- Rotate
- Positional language such as: next to, under, below, above, on top, between, beside.
