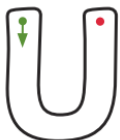
Literacy/Phonics:

Activity 1: Practice your letter formation, focusing on the capital letters: T, U, V, W.

Practice writing them in your book using the letter formation rhymes below.



Draw a straight line down and add a short line across the top.



Start at the top, go down, curl under and go straight back to the top.



A capital 'v' is the same as a lower-case 'v'. Just remember to make it bigger.



A capital 'w' is the same as a lower-case 'w'. Just remember to make it bigger.

Activity 2: Please complete some activities from the Level 4 phonics mat.



Mathematics:

This week, we have been composing and decomposing shapes.

Activity 1:

Cut a rectangle in half diagonally to create two identical right-angled triangles



How many new shapes can you make by fitting the triangles together? Can you make shapes with three sides or with four sides? Encourage children to return the two triangles back into a rectangular shape before investigating further.

Topic:

This week, we have been learning about seashores.

Activity 1: Write a list of things you would need to take to the beach.

Activity 2: Draw a picture of an animal you might find in a rock pool.



Below is a list of words we have been using in the classroom this week. Please encourage the use of these words at home:

- Habitat
- Ocean
- Coral reef
- Rockpool
- Fins, scales, tentacles
