



Reception Home Learning Activities

Literacy/Phonics:

Activity 1: Practice your letter formation, focusing on the capital letters: X, Y, Z.

Practice writing them in your book using the letter formation rhymes below.



A capital 'x' is the same as a lower-case 'x'. Just remember to make it bigger.



Draw a short line across and down, then another line from the right down to meet it, then down.



A capital 'z' is the same as a lower-case 'z'. Just remember to make it bigger.

Activity 2: Please complete some activities from the Level 4 phonics mat.



Topic:

This week, we have been learning about seaside holidays in the past.

Activity 1: Can you remember one thing that was different about the seaside in the past that we have talked about in class?

Tell someone at home what you remember, or draw a picture to show your idea.

Activity 2: Create a postcard from the beach! Draw a picture of the beach and what you might see there. Write a message to a friend or member of your family. Remember to use your phonics to sound out short words (like sun, sand, hot, fun).

Mathematics:

This week, we have been sharing into equal groups.

Activity 1: Share out 15 biscuits between your favourite 5 toys. How many biscuits does each toy have? Is it fair?

Try sharing different number of biscuits between different groups. Can 10 share equally between 2 groups? 3 groups? 5 groups?

Activity 2: Complete the sharing word problem below:

Logan has 3 rabbits who love eating carrots. He has 6 carrots to share between them. How many carrots will each rabbit have? Draw 3 rabbits and share out the carrots to check.
