



Reception Home Learning Activities

Literacy/Phonics:

Activity 1: Level 4 pirate words worksheet – use your phonics knowledge to sound out the Level 4 words and write them in your book.

Activity 2: practise writing your tricky words from memory in your book (tricky word mat attached separately).



Topic:

This week, we have been learning about sea pollution.

Activity 1: Create a poster about different ways we could help to keep our oceans clean.

Activity 2: Make a 3D octopus or jellyfish using paper chains as the tentacles. We'd love to see your creative ideas!



Mathematics:

This week, we have been using positional language.

Activity 1: Go on a walk and play a positions game with a friend or grown-up. Ask them to spot an object and you have to guess what it is. Ask them to give you clues to identify the object, e.g. "It is behind the fence." or "It is in front of the café."

Activity 2: Draw a treasure map on a piece of paper - draw an island in the middle of the paper. Draw a pirate ship next to the island on one side and a ship wreck on the other side. Above the island, draw some smaller islands for boats to move in and out of. Below the island, draw some hungry sharks. What else can you add to the map? Can you describe the position? Draw a cross on the map to show where some treasure is buried. Can you describe where the treasure is hidden?
